<b>fancy</b>	Have a fancy or particular liking or desire for. <i>All pelargoniums from scented leaf species to <b>fancy</b> hybrids thrive in hot sunshine.</i>
<b>fine</b>	Issue a ticket or a fine to as a penalty. <i>Another minute I d have been <b>fine</b>.</i>
<b>glorious</b>	Having great beauty and splendor. <i>A <b>glorious</b> work of art.</i>
<b>good</b>	Completely and absolutely good is sometimes used informally for thoroughly. <i>He convinces his father to use his genius for the <b>good</b> of mankind.</i>
<b>idealize</b>	Form ideals. <i>She <b>idealized</b> her husband after his death.</i>
<b>ideally</b>	In an ideal manner. <i><b>Ideally</b> you should exercise for 30 minutes every day.</i>
<b>imaginative</b>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>An <b>imaginative</b> use of material.</i>
<b>lively</b>	(of a place or atmosphere) full of activity and excitement. <i>A <b>lively</b> discussion.</i>
<b>luxuriant</b>	Displaying luxury and furnishing gratification to the senses. <i>She tossed her <b>luxuriant</b> dark hair.</i>
<b>magnificent</b>	Characterized by grandeur. <i><b>Magnificent</b> cathedrals.</i>

<b>overweening</b>	Unrestrained, especially with regard to feelings. <i>No idea how <b>overweening</b> he would be.</i>
<b>praise</b>	Express approval of. <i>He always appreciated <b>praise</b> for his work.</i>
<b>spirited</b>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A <b>spirited</b> dance.</i>
<b>sprightly</b>	Full of spirit and vitality. <i>A <b>sprightly</b> dance.</i>
<b>superbly</b>	Very well; excellently. <i>The tomb is <b>superbly</b> ornamented with fine tracery.</i>
<b>terrific</b>	Causing terror. <i>You look <b>terrific</b>.</i>
<b>vibrant</b>	Of sounds that are strong and resonating. <i>A huge room decorated in <b>vibrant</b> blues and greens.</i>
<b>vivacious</b>	Attractively lively and animated (typically used of a woman). <i>A <b>vivacious</b> folk dance.</i>
<b>well</b>	In a good or proper or satisfactory manner or to a high standard good is a nonstandard dialectal variant for well. <i>We knew them <b>well</b>.</i>
<b>wonderful</b>	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>The climate was <b>wonderful</b> all the year round.</i>
