| terrific | Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A terrific noise.</i> |
| tremendous | Very great in amount, scale, or intensity. <i>The crew did a tremendous job.</i> |
| wonderful | Inspiring delight, pleasure, or admiration; extremely good; marvellous. <i>They all think she s wonderful.</i> |
