rattling	Extraordinarily good or great; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A rattling old lift.</i>
<u>sublime</u>	Greatest or maximal in degree; extreme. <i>Experiences that ranged from the sublime to the ridiculous.</i>
superb	Used in names of birds with attractive or colourful plumage e.g superb lyrebird. <i>A superb performance.</i>
terrific	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A terrific noise.</i>
<u>tremendous</u>	Very great in amount, scale, or intensity. <i>The crew did a tremendous job.</i>
wonderful	Inspiring delight, pleasure, or admiration; extremely good; marvellous. <i>They all think she s wonderful.</i>
