<b>rattling</b>	Extraordinarily good or great; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A <b>rattling</b> old lift.</i>
<b>sublime</b>	Greatest or maximal in degree; extreme. <i>Experiences that ranged from the <b>sublime</b> to the ridiculous.</i>
<b>superb</b>	Used in names of birds with attractive or colourful plumage e.g superb lyrebird. <i>A <b>superb</b> performance.</i>
<b>terrific</b>	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A <b>terrific</b> noise.</i>
<b>tremendous</b>	Very great in amount, scale, or intensity. <i>The crew did a <b>tremendous</b> job.</i>
<b>wonderful</b>	Inspiring delight, pleasure, or admiration; extremely good; marvellous. <i>They all think she s <b>wonderful</b>.</i>
