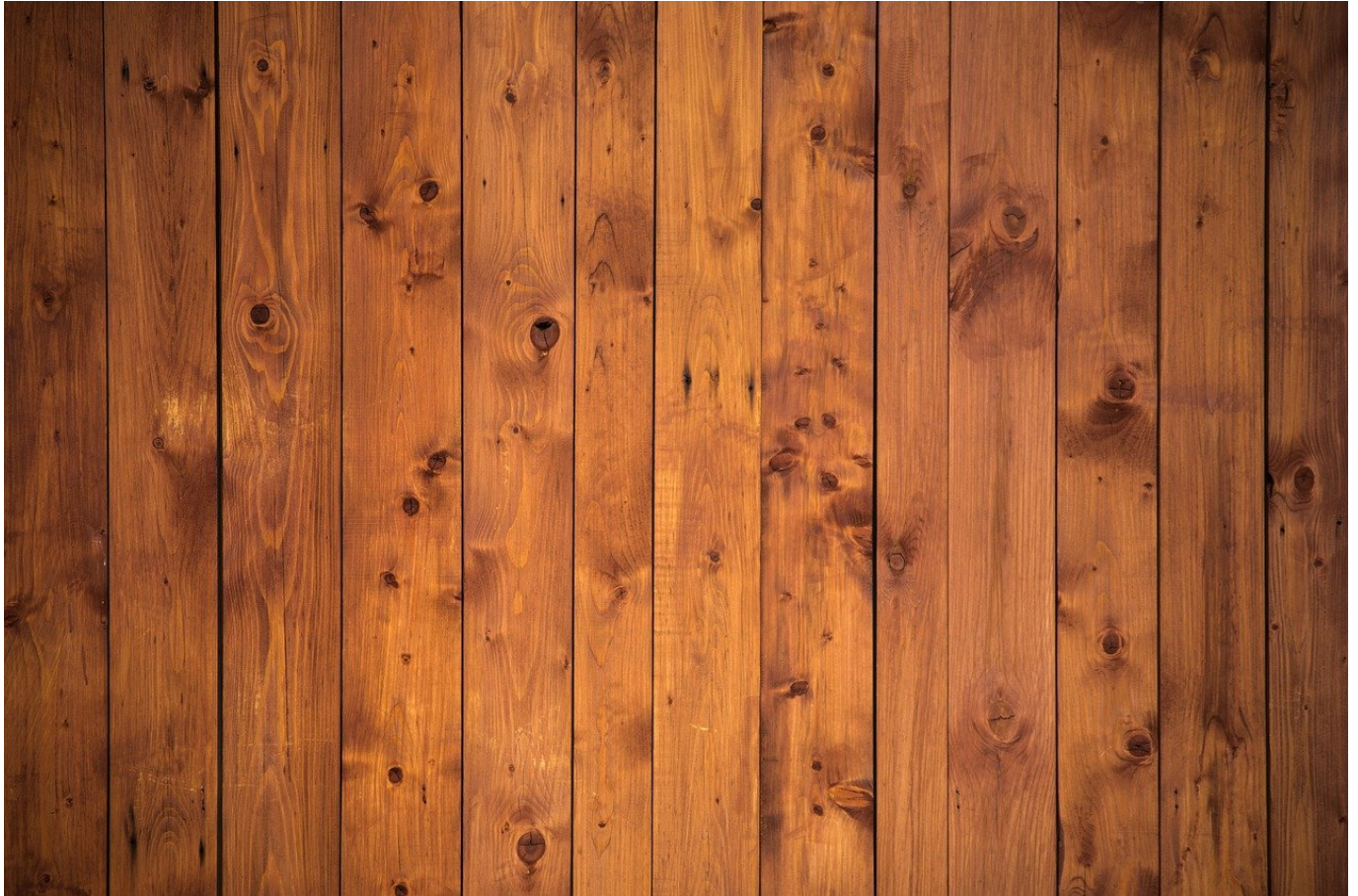
## Wood as a Noun

### Definitions of "Wood" as a noun

- *United States film actress (1938-1981).*
- *United States painter noted for works based on life in the Midwest (1892-1942).*
- *The hard fibrous lignified substance under the bark of trees.*
- *A golf club with a wooden or other head that is relatively broad from face to back (often with a numeral indicating the degree to which the face is angled to loft the ball).*
- *Any wind instrument other than the brass instruments.*
- *The trees and other plants in a large densely wooded area.*
- *English conductor (1869-1944).*
- *Wooden barrels used for storing alcoholic drinks.*
- *An area of land, smaller than a forest, that is covered with growing trees.*
- *English writer of novels about murders and thefts and forgeries (1814-1887).*
- *A shot made with a wood.*
- *A golf club with a long shaft used to hit long shots; originally made with a wooden head.*
- *The hard fibrous material that forms the main substance of the trunk or branches of a*

*tree or shrub, used for fuel or timber.*

<b>ellen price wood</b>	Cost of bribing someone.
<b>firewood</b>	Wood that is burnt as fuel. <i>They collected and cut their own <b>firewood</b>.</i>
<b>forest</b>	Denoting an area that was formerly a royal forest. <i>A large tract of <b>forest</b>.</i>
<b>grant wood</b>	A contract granting the right to operate a subsidiary business.
<b>kindling</b>	Material for starting a fire.
<b>logs</b>	The exponent required to produce a given number. <i>They kept a log of all transmission by the radio station.</i>
<b>mrs. henry wood</b>	English writer of novels about murders and thefts and forgeries (1814-1887).

<b>natalie wood</b>	A golf club with a long shaft used to hit long shots; originally made with a wooden head.
<b>planking</b>	Planks collectively, especially when used for flooring or as part of a boat. <i>The waves had pulled her deck <b>planking</b> apart.</i>
<b>planks</b>	An endorsed policy in the platform of a political party.
<b>sir henry joseph wood</b>	A title used before the name of knight or baronet.
<b>sir henry wood</b>	Term of address for a man.
<b>timber</b>	Used to warn that a tree is about to fall after being cut. <i>The exploitation of forests for <b>timber</b>.</i>
<b>trees</b>	A figure that branches from a single root. <i>Genealogical tree.</i>
<b>woodland</b>	Land that is covered with trees and shrubs. <i>Large areas of ancient <b>woodland</b>.</i>
<b>woods</b>	United States film actress (1938-1981).
<b>woodwind</b>	Wind instruments other than brass instruments forming a section of an orchestra, including flutes, oboes, clarinets, and bassoons. <i>Striking passages for <b>woodwind</b> and brass.</i>
<b>woodwind instrument</b>	Any wind instrument other than the brass instruments.

- *He hit the ball with a three-wood.*
- *Best quality woods were used for joinery.*
- *A thick hedge divided the wood from the field.*

## Associations of "Wood" (30 Words)

- alder** Wood of any of various alder trees resistant to underwater rot used for bridges etc.
- arboreal** Relating to trees.  
*Arboreal apes.*
- aspen** A poplar tree with small rounded long-stalked leaves that tremble in the breeze.
- balsam** A tree or shrub which yields balsam.  
*A hair conditioner with protein and **balsams**.*
- bamboo** The hollow jointed stem of the bamboo plant used as a cane or to make furniture and implements.  
*A section of **bamboo** about four feet long.*
- birch** Consisting of or made of wood of the birch tree.  
*There were calls to bring back the **birch**.*

<b>conifer</b>	A tree that bears cones and needle-like or scale-like leaves that are typically evergreen. Conifers are of major importance as the source of softwood, and also supply resins and turpentine.
<b>cottonwood</b>	A North American poplar with seeds covered in white cottony hairs.
<b>elm</b>	Hard tough wood of an elm tree used for e.g. implements and furniture.
<b>eucalyptus</b>	The oil from eucalyptus leaves chiefly used for its medicinal properties.
<b>evergreen</b>	(of plants and shrubs) bearing foliage throughout the year. <i>Evergreens planted to cut off the east wind.</i>
<b>fir</b>	Nonresinous wood of a fir tree.
<b>forest</b>	Establish a forest on previously unforested land. <i>A pine forest.</i>
<b>ivy</b>	Used in names of climbing plants similar to ivy e.g. poison ivy Boston ivy. <i>One would think that seats at these public Ivies would be reserved for graduates of that state's high schools.</i>
<b>juniper</b>	Desert shrub of Syria and Arabia having small white flowers constitutes the juniper of the Old Testament sometimes placed in genus Genista.
<b>mantel</b>	A mantelpiece or mantelshelf.
<b>maple</b>	Wood of any of various maple trees especially the hard close grained wood of the sugar maple used especially for furniture and flooring.
<b>oak</b>	Used in names of other trees or plants that resemble the oaks in some way e.g. she oak silky oak. <i>Great oaks grow from little acorns.</i>
<b>parquet</b>	A floor made of parquetry. <i>The intricate parquet floors.</i>
<b>pine</b>	Used in names of coniferous trees of families other than that of the pine e.g. Chile pine. <i>Pine potpourri.</i>
<b>plant</b>	Put a seed bulb or plant in the ground so that it can grow. <i>She planted a kiss on his cheek.</i>
<b>plywood</b>	A laminate made of thin layers of wood. <i>Plywood benches.</i>
<b>poplar</b>	Soft light colored non durable wood of the poplar.
<b>redwood</b>	Used in names of a number of chiefly tropical trees with reddish timber e.g. Andaman redwood.
<b>sapling</b>	Young tree. <i>What god or mortal reared up so fair a sapling.</i>



- stem** Remove the stems from fruit or tobacco leaves.  
*The main **stem** of the wing feathers.*
- tree** A thing that has a branching structure resembling that of a tree.  
*Genealogical **tree**.*
- willow** A textile machine having a system of revolving spikes for opening and cleaning raw textile fibers.
- woodland** Land covered with trees.  
*Large areas of ancient **woodland**.*
- xylem** The vascular tissue in plants which conducts water and dissolved nutrients upwards from the root and also helps to form the woody element in the stem.
