
Definitions of "Wood" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "wood" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- United States film actress (1938-1981.
- United States painter noted for works based on life in the Midwest (1892-1942.
- The hard fibrous lignified substance under the bark of trees.
- A golf club with a wooden or other head that is relatively broad from face to back (often with a numeral indicating the degree to which the face is angled to loft the ball.
- Any wind instrument other than the brass instruments.
- The trees and other plants in a large densely wooded area.
- English conductor (1869-1944.
- Wooden barrels used for storing alcoholic drinks.
- An area of land, smaller than a forest, that is covered with growing trees.
- English writer of novels about murders and thefts and forgeries (1814-1887.
- A shot made with a wood.
- A golf club with a long shaft used to hit long shots; originally made with a wooden head.
- The hard fibrous material that forms the main substance of the trunk or branches of a



tree or shrub, used for fuel or timber.

sir henry wood	Term of address for a man.	
timber	Used to warn that a tree is about to fall after being cut. <i>The exploitation of forests for timber</i> .	
trees	A figure that branches from a single root. <i>Genealogical tree</i> .	
woodland	Land that is covered with trees and shrubs. Large areas of ancient woodland .	
woods	United States film actress (1938-1981.	
woodwind	Wind instruments other than brass instruments forming a section of an orchestra, including flutes, oboes, clarinets, and bassoons. <i>Striking passages for woodwind and brass.</i>	
woodwind instrument Any wind instrument other than the brass instruments.

Associations of "Wood" (30 Words)

alder	Wood of any of various alder trees resistant to underwater rot used for bridges etc.
<u>arboreal</u>	Relating to trees. Arboreal apes.
aspen	A poplar tree with small rounded long-stalked leaves that tremble in the breeze.
balsam	A tree or shrub which yields balsam. A hair conditioner with protein and balsam s.
bamboo	The hollow jointed stem of the bamboo plant used as a cane or to make furniture and implements. A section of bamboo about four feet long.
birch	Consisting of or made of wood of the birch tree. There were calls to bring back the birch .



conifer	A tree that bears cones and needle-like or scale-like leaves that are typically evergreen. Conifers are of major importance as the source of softwood, and also supply resins and turpentine.
cottonwood	A North American poplar with seeds covered in white cottony hairs.
elm	Hard tough wood of an elm tree used for e g implements and furniture.
eucalyptus	The oil from eucalyptus leaves chiefly used for its medicinal properties.
evergreen	(of plants and shrubs) bearing foliage throughout the year. Evergreen s planted to cut off the east wind.
fir	Nonresinous wood of a fir tree.
forest	Establish a forest on previously unforested land. A pine forest .
ivy	Used in names of climbing plants similar to ivy e g poison ivy Boston ivy. One would think that seats at these public Ivies would be reserved for graduates of that state's high schools.
juniper	Desert shrub of Syria and Arabia having small white flowers constitutes the juniper of the Old Testament sometimes placed in genus Genista.
mantel	A mantelpiece or mantelshelf.
maple	Wood of any of various maple trees especially the hard close grained wood of the sugar maple used especially for furniture and flooring.
oak	Used in names of other trees or plants that resemble the oaks in some way e g she oak silky oak. <i>Great oaks grow from little acorns.</i>
parquet	A floor made of parquetry. The intricate parquet floors.
pine	Used in names of coniferous trees of families other than that of the pine e g Chile pine. <i>Pine potpourri.</i>
plant	Put a seed bulb or plant in the ground so that it can grow. She plant ed a kiss on his cheek.
plywood	A laminate made of thin layers of wood. <i>Plywood</i> benches.
poplar	Soft light colored non durable wood of the poplar.
redwood	Used in names of a number of chiefly tropical trees with reddish timber e g Andaman redwood.
sapling	Young tree. What god or mortal reared up so fair a sapling .



<u>stem</u>	Remove the stems from fruit or tobacco leaves. The main stem of the wing feathers.
tree	A thing that has a branching structure resembling that of a tree. Genealogical tree .
willow	A textile machine having a system of revolving spikes for opening and cleaning raw textile fibers.
woodland	Land covered with trees. Large areas of ancient woodland .
xylem	The vascular tissue in plants which conducts water and dissolved nutrients upwards from the root and also beins to form the woody element in the stem
