<u>accomplish</u>	Achieve or complete successfully. The planes accomplish ed their mission.

<u>cooperatively</u>	In close cooperation. The two publishers will work cooperatively on poster projects.

employed	(of a person) having a paid job. Most of our graduates are employed .
employment	The action of giving work to someone. <i>He travelled in a variety of employments.</i>
<u>engaged</u>	Having ones attention or mind or energy engaged. Keith and I had got engaged four months before.
hired	Hired for the exclusive temporary use of a group of travelers. A <i>hired</i> assassin.
<u>interact</u>	Act in such a way as to have an effect on each other. All the stages in the process interact .
job	A workplace as in the expression on the job. <i>If left unfettered he would job.</i>



labor	A political party formed in Great Britain in 1900 characterized by the promotion of labor s interests and formerly the socialization of key industries. There is a shortage of skilled labor in this field.
<u>menial</u>	A person with a menial job. <i>Menial factory jobs.</i>
overtime	Payment for overtime. His brain was working overtime .
partnership	A contract between two or more persons who agree to pool talent and money and share profits or losses. <i>An increase in partnerships with housing associations.</i>
<u>proletariat</u>	The lowest class of citizens in ancient Rome. The growth of the industrial proletariat .
reconstruction	The action or process of reconstructing or being reconstructed. A reconstruction of the accident would be staged to try to discover the cause of the tragedy.
recruiter	Someone who supplies members or employees. A recruiter will schedule you for an interview.
recruitment	The action of finding new people to join an organization or support a cause. The black tailed deer is notoriously capable of population recruitment after numbers are depleted.
scullion	A servant assigned the most menial kitchen tasks.
semiskilled	Possessing or requiring limited skills. A semiskilled job.
subcontract	Work under a subcontract engage in a subcontract. Subcontract work.
successfully	In a way that accomplishes a desired aim or result. She has successfully completed her mission.
task	Assign a task to. A new manager was given the task of developing the club s talent.
toil	Productive work (especially physical work done for wages. She began to toil up the cliff path.
travail	Painful or laborious effort. Advice for those who wish to save great sorrow and travail .
<u>unskilled</u>	Not doing a good job. Unskilled in the art of rhetoric.
