- conscientious** Guided by or in accordance with conscience or sense of right and wrong.
*A **conscientious** man he took his duties very seriously.*
- cooperatively** (in relation to the owning or running of a business) jointly by a group of people, with profits or benefits shared among them.
*The two publishers will work **cooperatively** on poster projects.*
- diligence** Conscientiousness in paying proper attention to a task; giving the degree of care required in a given situation.
*His **diligence** won him quick promotions.*
- diligent** Quietly and steadily persevering especially in detail or exactness.
*A **diligent** search of the files.*
- drudgery** Hard monotonous routine work.
*Domestic **drudgery**.*

employment	The act of giving someone a job. <i>They are looking for employment.</i>
engaged	Of facilities such as telephones or lavatories unavailable for use by anyone else or indicating unavailability engaged is a British term for a busy telephone line. <i>Deeply engaged in conversation.</i>
functional	Designed for or adapted to a function or use. <i>A small functional bathroom.</i>
hardworking	Characterized by hard work and perseverance.
hire	Engage or hire for work. <i>We flew to San Diego hired a car and headed for Las Vegas.</i>
hired	Hired for the exclusive temporary use of a group of travelers. <i>A hired gun.</i>
industrious	Diligent and hard-working. <i>An industrious people striving to make their country prosperous.</i>
interact	Act together or towards others or with others. <i>All the stages in the process interact.</i>
labor	An organized attempt by workers to improve their status by united action particularly via labor unions or the leaders of this movement. <i>His labor did not require a great deal of skill.</i>
meticulous	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>He had always been so meticulous about his appearance.</i>
occupied	Held or filled or in use. <i>She keeps her time well occupied.</i>
overtime	Payment for overtime. <i>The company could not afford to pay overtime.</i>
painstaking	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>Painstaking research.</i>
partnership	An association of two or more people as partners. <i>Their 176 run third wicket partnership.</i>
plodding	(of a person) thorough and hard-working but lacking in imagination or intelligence. <i>A plodding comedy drama.</i>
scrupulous	Very concerned to avoid doing wrong. <i>She s too scrupulous to have an affair with a married man.</i>

sedulous	Marked by care and persistent effort. <i>He watched himself with the most sedulous care.</i>
semiskilled	Possessing or requiring limited skills. <i>A semiskilled job.</i>
studious	Showing great care or attention. <i>Made a studious attempt to fix the television set.</i>
successfully	In a way that accomplishes a desired aim or result. <i>She has successfully completed her mission.</i>
work	Give a workout to. <i>This artist works mostly in acrylics.</i>
worker	A neuter or undeveloped female bee, wasp, ant, or other social insect, large numbers of which do the basic work of the colony. <i>He is a good worker.</i>
