blouse	A top worn by women. I blouse d my trousers over my boots.
<u>boot</u>	Kick give a boot to. He got a boot in the stomach.
<u>cape</u>	In bullfighting taunt the bull by flourishing a cape. The robe was decorated with gold lace on the fronts cape and hem.
chiffon	A sheer fabric of silk or rayon. <i>Chiffon cake</i> .
doff	Take off or raise (one's hat) as a greeting or token of respect. The manager doff ed his hat to her.
<u>dress</u>	Clean treat or apply a dressing to a wound. Can the child dress by herself.
fez	A felt cap (usually red) for a man; shaped like a flat-topped cone with a tassel that hangs from the crown.
floppy	A small plastic magnetic disk enclosed in a stiff envelope with a radial slit; used to store data or programs for a microcomputer. <i>A spaniel with floppy ears.</i>
glove	Of a wicketkeeper baseball catcher etc catch deflect or touch the ball with a gloved hand. Vaughan glove d it and got to his knees to throw.
gown	A dressing gown. She was gown ed in luminous silk.
<u>hat</u>	Put on or wear a hat. A black straw hat .
headdress	Clothing for the head. A tall plumed headdress .
hosiery	Stockings, socks, and tights collectively.



jacket	The dust jacket of a book. Potatoes cooked in their jacket s.
jean	Close-fitting trousers of heavy denim for manual work or casual wear. A jean jacket.
<u>lax</u>	Of a speech sound especially a vowel pronounced with the vocal muscles relaxed. <i>Lax in attending classes.</i>
loincloth	A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some hot countries as their only garment.
mitten	Boxing gloves.
monocle	A single eyeglass, kept in position by the muscles around the eye.
<u>pants</u>	Underpants or knickers. <i>Corduroy pants.</i>
<u>robe</u>	Put on robes especially for a formal or ceremonial occasion. A baby in christening robe s.
<u>scarf</u>	Wrap in or adorn with a scarf. A silk scarf .
<u>shirt</u>	A garment similar to a shirt made of stretchable material and typically having a short row of buttons at the neck worn as casual wear or for sports. <i>Tonight he s smartly dressed in shirt and tie.</i>
shorts	Men's underpants. <i>Cycling shorts.</i>
skirt	Cloth covering that forms the part of a garment below the waist. <i>She skirted the problem.</i>
sweater	An employer who works employees hard in poor conditions for low pay. A close knit wool sweater for icy weather.
swimsuit	Tight fitting garment worn for swimming.
undergarment	t A garment worn under other garments.
underwear	Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments.
uniformed	Wearing a uniform. Uniformed police officers.
