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## Associations of "Worn down" (30 Words)

<b>blouse</b>	A top worn by women. <i>I <b>bloused</b> my trousers over my boots.</i>
<b>boot</b>	Kick give a boot to. <i>He got a <b>boot</b> in the stomach.</i>
<b>cape</b>	In bullfighting taunt the bull by flourishing a cape. <i>The robe was decorated with gold lace on the fronts <b>cape</b> and hem.</i>
<b>chiffon</b>	A sheer fabric of silk or rayon. <i><b>Chiffon</b> cake.</i>
<b>doff</b>	Take off or raise (one’s hat) as a greeting or token of respect. <i>The manager <b>doffed</b> his hat to her.</i>
<b>dress</b>	Clean treat or apply a dressing to a wound. <i>Can the child <b>dress</b> by herself.</i>
<b>fez</b>	A felt cap (usually red) for a man; shaped like a flat-topped cone with a tassel that hangs from the crown.
<b>floppy</b>	A small plastic magnetic disk enclosed in a stiff envelope with a radial slit; used to store data or programs for a microcomputer. <i>A spaniel with <b>floppy</b> ears.</i>
<b>glove</b>	Of a wicketkeeper baseball catcher etc catch deflect or touch the ball with a gloved hand. <i>Vaughan <b>gloved</b> it and got to his knees to throw.</i>
<b>gown</b>	A dressing gown. <i>She was <b>gowned</b> in luminous silk.</i>
<b>hat</b>	Put on or wear a hat. <i>A black straw <b>hat</b>.</i>
<b>headdress</b>	Clothing for the head. <i>A tall plumed <b>headdress</b>.</i>
<b>hosiery</b>	Stockings, socks, and tights collectively.

<b>jacket</b>	The dust jacket of a book. <i>Potatoes cooked in their <b>jackets</b>.</i>
<b>jean</b>	Close-fitting trousers of heavy denim for manual work or casual wear. <i>A <b>jean</b> jacket.</i>
<b><u>lax</u></b>	Of a speech sound especially a vowel pronounced with the vocal muscles relaxed. <i><b>Lax</b> in attending classes.</i>
<b>loincloth</b>	A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some hot countries as their only garment.
<b>mitten</b>	Boxing gloves.
<b>monocle</b>	A single eyeglass, kept in position by the muscles around the eye.
<b><u>pants</u></b>	Underpants or knickers. <i>Corduroy <b>pants</b>.</i>
<b><u>robe</u></b>	Put on robes especially for a formal or ceremonial occasion. <i>A baby in christening <b>robes</b>.</i>
<b><u>scarf</u></b>	Wrap in or adorn with a scarf. <i>A silk <b>scarf</b>.</i>
<b><u>shirt</u></b>	A garment similar to a shirt made of stretchable material and typically having a short row of buttons at the neck worn as casual wear or for sports. <i>Tonight he s smartly dressed in <b>shirt</b> and tie.</i>
<b>shorts</b>	Men's underpants. <i>Cycling <b>shorts</b>.</i>
<b>skirt</b>	Cloth covering that forms the part of a garment below the waist. <i>She <b>skirted</b> the problem.</i>
<b>sweater</b>	An employer who works employees hard in poor conditions for low pay. <i>A close knit wool <b>sweater</b> for icy weather.</i>
<b>swimsuit</b>	Tight fitting garment worn for swimming.
<b>undergarment</b>	A garment worn under other garments.
<b>underwear</b>	Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments.
<b>uniformed</b>	Wearing a uniform. <i><b>Uniformed</b> police officers.</i>
