# **Conjugate Wring**

#### Wring in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>wring</b>	We <b>wring</b>
You <b>wring</b>	You <b>wring</b>
He/She/It wrings	They wring

## Wring in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am wringing	We <b>are wringing</b>
You <b>are wringing</b>	You <b>are wringing</b>
He/She/It is wringing	They <b>are wringing</b>

#### Wring in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have wrung or wringed	We have wrung or wringed
You <b>have wrung or wringed</b>	You have wrung or wringed
He/She/It has wrung or wringed	They have wrung or wringed

## Wring in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been wringing	We have been wringing
You <b>have been wringing</b>	You have been wringing
He/She/It has been wringing	They have been wringing

## Wring in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I wrang or wrung or (obsolete) wringed	We <b>wrang or wrung or (obsolete)</b> wringed
You <b>wrang or wrung or (obsolete)</b>	You <b>wrang or wrung or (obsolete)</b>
wringed	wringed
He/She/It <b>wrang or wrung or (obsolete)</b>	They <b>wrang or wrung or (obsolete)</b>
wringed	wringed



## Wring in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was wringing	We <b>were wringing</b>
You <b>were wringing</b>	You <b>were wringing</b>
He/She/It was wringing	They were wringing

#### Wring in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had wrung or wringed	We had wrung or wringed
You <b>had wrung or wringed</b>	You <b>had wrung or wringed</b>
He/She/It had wrung or wringed	They had wrung or wringed

## Wring in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been wringing	We had been wringing
You <b>had been wringing</b>	You <b>had been wringing</b>
He/She/It had been wringing	They had been wringing

#### Wring in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will wring	We will wring
You <b>will wring</b>	You <b>will wring</b>
He/She/It will wring	They will wring

#### Wring in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be wringing	We <b>will be wringing</b>
You <b>will be wringing</b>	You <b>will be wringing</b>
He/She/It will be wringing	They will be wringing



#### Wring in Future Perfect Tense

SingularPluralI will have wrung or wringedWe will have wrung or wringedYou will have wrung or wringedYou will have wrung or wringedHe/She/It will have wrung or wringedThey will have wrung or wringed

#### Wring in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

SingularPluralI will have been wringingWe will have been wringingYou will have been wringingYou will have been wringingHe/She/It will have been wringingThey will have been wringing
