Associations of "Write down" (30 Words)

anthology	A collection of selected literary passages. <i>A double CD anthology of Moby Grape the legendary Sixties San Francisco band.</i>
author	The writings produced by a particular author. <i>He is the author of several books on the subject.</i>
bard	A poet, traditionally one reciting epics and associated with a particular oral tradition. <i>Our national bard Robert Burns.</i>
descend	Move down (a slope or stairs). <i>As the winter darkness descended the fighting ceased.</i>
descending	Moving down a scale of quality. <i>The categories are listed in descending order of usefulness.</i>
descent	A moral, social, or psychological decline. <i>A steep badly eroded descent.</i>
disparagement	A communication that belittles somebody or something.
disquisition	An elaborate analytical or explanatory essay or discussion. <i>Nothing can kill a radio show quicker than a disquisition on intertextual analysis.</i>
downward	Moving or leading towards a lower place or level. <i>Prices plunged downward.</i>
emblazon	Celebrate or extol publicly. <i>The Queen s coat of arms is emblazoned on the door panel.</i>
enroll	Register formally as a participant or member.
epic	The genre of epics. <i>An epic voyage.</i>
falling	Becoming lower or less in degree or value. <i>A falling market.</i>

indite	Write; compose. <i>He indites the wondrous tale of Our Lord.</i>
low	A low point level or figure. <i>Cook over low heat.</i>
manuscript	Handwritten book or document. <i>Early Gothic manuscripts.</i>
marker	(in team games) a player who stays close to an opponent to prevent them from getting or passing the ball. <i>A heavy line drawn by a marker.</i>
nether	Lower in position. <i>Gnawed his nether lip.</i>
notebook	A book with blank pages for recording notes or memoranda. <i>He copied the number into his notebook.</i>
pen	An electronic device like a pen used in conjunction with a writing surface to enter commands or data into a computer. <i>Olivia penned award winning poetry.</i>
pencil	Write draw or colour with a pencil. <i>A pencil of light.</i>
poem	A piece of writing in which the expression of feelings and ideas is given intensity by particular attention to diction (sometimes involving rhyme), rhythm, and imagery. <i>Lyric poems.</i>
poet	A writer of poems the term is usually reserved for writers of good poetry. <i>He is more poet than academic because of his gift for language.</i>
poetic	Relating to or used in poetry. <i>Turner s vision of the rainbow was poetic.</i>
poetics	The art of writing poetry. <i>The terminology of traditional poetics.</i>
prose	A passage of prose for translation into a foreign language. <i>A short story in prose.</i>
recognizance	A bond by which a person undertakes before a court or magistrate to observe some condition, especially to appear when summoned. <i>The Lord Chancellor asked them to enter into recognizances to appear in court.</i>
signpost	Indicate a place with a signpost. <i>Most of the walks were well signposted.</i>
submergence	The process or state of being submerged in or covered with water. <i>Total submergence of plants results in heavy crop losses.</i>
