The Forms of Write

Infinitive	to write
Present Tense	write / writes
Past Tense	wrote or (archaic) writ
Present Participle	writing
Past Participle	written or writ

Conjugate Write

Write in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **write** We **write**
You **write** You **write**
He/She/It **writes** They **write**

Write in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am writing** We **are writing**
You **are writing** You **are writing**
He/She/It **is writing** They **are writing**

Write in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have written or writ** We **have written or writ**
You **have written or writ** You **have written or writ**
He/She/It **has written or writ** They **have written or writ**

Write in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been writing** We **have been writing**
You **have been writing** You **have been writing**
He/She/It **has been writing** They **have been writing**

Write in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **wrote or (archaic) writ** We **wrote or (archaic) writ**
You **wrote or (archaic) writ** You **wrote or (archaic) writ**
He/She/It **wrote or (archaic) writ** They **wrote or (archaic) writ**

Write in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was writing We were writing
You were writing You were writing
He/She/It was writing They were writing

Write in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had written or writ We had written or writ
You had written or writ You had written or writ
He/She/It had written or writ They had written or writ

Write in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been writing We had been writing
You had been writing You had been writing
He/She/It had been writing They had been writing

Write in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will write We will write
You will write You will write
He/She/It will write They will write

Write in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be writing We will be writing
You will be writing You will be writing
He/She/It will be writing They will be writing

Write in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have written or writ

We will have written or writ

You will have written or writ

You will have written or writ

He/She/It will have written or writ **They will have written or writ**

Write in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been writing

We will have been writing

You will have been writing

You will have been writing

He/She/It will have been writing **They will have been writing**
