### **Definitions of "Written" as an adjective**

- *Written as for a film or play or broadcast.*
- *Systematically collected and written down.*
- *Set down in writing in any of various ways.*

## Associations of "Written" (30 Words)

<b>acronym</b>	An abbreviation formed from the initial letters of other words and pronounced as a word (e.g. ASCII, NASA). <i>The word <b>scuba</b> is an <b>acronym</b> for <b>s</b>elf <b>c</b>ontained <b>u</b>nderwater <b>b</b>reathing <b>a</b>pparatus.</i>
<b>address</b>	Access or locate by address. <i>She <b>addressed</b> my father as Mr Stevens.</i>
<b>aforementioned</b>	Denoting a thing or person previously mentioned. <i>Works of all the <b>aforementioned</b> authors.</i>
<b>aforsaid</b>	Being the one previously mentioned or spoken of.
<b>alphabetic</b>	Relating to or expressed by a writing system that uses an alphabet. <i>An <b>alphabetic</b> arrangement.</i>
<b>announcement</b>	The action of making an announcement. <i>The <b>announcement</b> of the decision of the European Parliament.</i>

<b>congratulatory</b>	Conveying good wishes or praise to someone in response to an achievement or special occasion. <i>The usual <b>congratulatory</b> crowd was conspicuously absent.</i>
<b>correspondence</b>	Letters, emails, etc. sent or received. <i>The results of two tests were in <b>correspondence</b>.</i>
<b>cursive</b>	Rapid handwriting in which letters are set down in full and are cursively connected within words without lifting the writing implement from the paper. <i><b>Cursive</b> script.</i>
<b>declarative</b>	A declarative sentence or phrase. <i><b>Declarative</b> statements.</i>
<b>dissertation</b>	A long essay on a particular subject, especially one written for a university degree or diploma. <i>A <b>dissertation</b> on the novels of the Bront sisters.</i>
<b>document</b>	Support or accompany with documentation. <i>The parents <b>documented</b> every step of their child s development.</i>
<b>email</b>	Send an email to someone. <i><b>Email</b> messages.</i>
<b>encyclical</b>	A letter from the pope sent to all Roman Catholic bishops throughout the world. <i>An <b>encyclical</b> letter.</i>
<b>handwriting</b>	A person's particular style of writing. <i>Her <b>handwriting</b> was small and neat.</i>
<b>holographic</b>	Written entirely in one's own hand. <i><b>Holographic</b> storage discs.</i>
<b>indicative</b>	The indicative mood. <i><b>Indicative</b> mood.</i>
<b>informing</b>	To furnish incriminating evidence to an officer of the law (usually in return for favors.
<b>letter</b>	Win an athletic letter. <i>Your personality matters far more than <b>letters</b> after your name.</i>
<b>message</b>	Send a message to someone especially by email text app or other electronic means. <i>She <b>messaged</b> the committee.</i>
<b>pager</b>	An electronic device that generates a series of beeps when the person carrying it is being paged.

<b>postscript</b>	An extra piece of information about an event that is added after it has happened. <i>He added a <b>postscript</b> Leaving tomorrow.</i>
<b>promulgation</b>	The official announcement of a new law or ordinance whereby the law or ordinance is put into effect. <i>The <b>promulgation</b> was written in English.</i>
<a href="#"><u>relay</u></a>	A signal or broadcast transmitted by a relay. <i>Gangs of workers were sent in <b>relays</b>.</i>
<b>report</b>	An employee who reports to another employee. <i>Undisclosed illegalities are <b>reported</b> to the company s directors.</i>
<b>sender</b>	Someone who transmits a message. <i>Evidence submitted late will be returned to the <b>sender</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>subliminal</u></a>	Below the threshold of conscious perception.
<b>telegram</b>	A message sent by telegraph and then delivered in written or printed form, used in the UK only for international messages since 1981.
<b>telegraphic</b>	Of or relating to or transmitted by telegraph. <i><b>Telegraphic</b> speech.</i>
<a href="#"><u>text</u></a>	Send someone a text message. <i>There were more than a thousand words of <b>text</b>.</i>
