## The Forms of Wrong

Infinitive	<b>to wrong</b>
Present Tense	<b>wrong / wrongs</b>
Past Tense	<b>wronged</b>
Present Participle	<b>wronging</b>
Past Participle	<b>wronged</b>

## Conjugate Wrong

**Wrong in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>wrong</b>	We <b>wrong</b>
You <b>wrong</b>	You <b>wrong</b>
He/She/It <b>wrongs</b>	They <b>wrong</b>

## **Wrong in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am wronging</b>	We <b>are wronging</b>
You <b>are wronging</b>	You <b>are wronging</b>
He/She/It <b>is wronging</b>	They <b>are wronging</b>

## **Wrong in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have wronged</b>	We <b>have wronged</b>
You <b>have wronged</b>	You <b>have wronged</b>
He/She/It <b>has wronged</b>	They <b>have wronged</b>

## **Wrong in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been wronging</b>	We <b>have been wronging</b>
You <b>have been wronging</b>	You <b>have been wronging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been wronging</b>	They <b>have been wronging</b>

## **Wrong in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>wronged</b>	We <b>wronged</b>
You <b>wronged</b>	You <b>wronged</b>
He/She/It <b>wronged</b>	They <b>wronged</b>

## **Wrong in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was wronging</b>	<b>We were wronging</b>
<b>You were wronging</b>	<b>You were wronging</b>
<b>He/She/It was wronging</b>	<b>They were wronging</b>

**Wrong in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had wronged</b>	<b>We had wronged</b>
<b>You had wronged</b>	<b>You had wronged</b>
<b>He/She/It had wronged</b>	<b>They had wronged</b>

**Wrong in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been wronging</b>	<b>We had been wronging</b>
<b>You had been wronging</b>	<b>You had been wronging</b>
<b>He/She/It had been wronging</b>	<b>They had been wronging</b>

**Wrong in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will wrong</b>	<b>We will wrong</b>
<b>You will wrong</b>	<b>You will wrong</b>
<b>He/She/It will wrong</b>	<b>They will wrong</b>

**Wrong in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be wronging</b>	<b>We will be wronging</b>
<b>You will be wronging</b>	<b>You will be wronging</b>
<b>He/She/It will be wronging</b>	<b>They will be wronging</b>

**Wrong in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have wronged**

**We will have wronged**

**You will have wronged**

**You will have wronged**

**He/She/It will have wronged**

**They will have wronged**

**Wrong in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been wronging**

**We will have been wronging**

**You will have been wronging**

**You will have been wronging**

**He/She/It will have been wronging**

**They will have been wronging**
