Infinitive	<b>to yang</b>
Present Tense	<b>yang / yangs</b>
Past Tense	<b>yanged</b>
Present Participle	<b>yanging</b>
Past Participle	<b>yanged</b>

## Conjugate Yang

**Yang in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>yang</b>	We <b>yang</b>
You <b>yang</b>	You <b>yang</b>
He/She/It <b>yangs</b>	They <b>yang</b>

## **Yang in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am yanging</b>	We <b>are yanging</b>
You <b>are yanging</b>	You <b>are yanging</b>
He/She/It <b>is yanging</b>	They <b>are yanging</b>

## **Yang in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have yanged</b>	We <b>have yanged</b>
You <b>have yanged</b>	You <b>have yanged</b>
He/She/It <b>has yanged</b>	They <b>have yanged</b>

## **Yang in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been yanging</b>	We <b>have been yanging</b>
You <b>have been yanging</b>	You <b>have been yanging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been yanging</b>	They <b>have been yanging</b>

## **Yang in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>yanged</b>	We <b>yanged</b>
You <b>yanged</b>	You <b>yanged</b>
He/She/It <b>yanged</b>	They <b>yanged</b>

## **Yang in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I **was yanging**                      We **were yanging**  
You **were yanging**              You **were yanging**  
He/She/It **was yanging**      They **were yanging**

**Yang in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **had yanged**                      We **had yanged**  
You **had yanged**                  You **had yanged**  
He/She/It **had yanged**      They **had yanged**

**Yang in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **had been yanging**              We **had been yanging**  
You **had been yanging**          You **had been yanging**  
He/She/It **had been yanging**      They **had been yanging**

**Yang in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **will yang**                      We **will yang**  
You **will yang**                  You **will yang**  
He/She/It **will yang**      They **will yang**

**Yang in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **will be yanging**                  We **will be yanging**  
You **will be yanging**              You **will be yanging**  
He/She/It **will be yanging**      They **will be yanging**

**Plural**

**I will have yanged**

**We will have yanged**

**You will have yanged**

**You will have yanged**

**He/She/It will have yanged**

**They will have yanged**

**Yang in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been yanging**

**We will have been yanging**

**You will have been yanging**

**You will have been yanging**

**He/She/It will have been yanging**

**They will have been yanging**
