abstinence	The trait of abstaining (especially from alcohol). <i>Abstinence from premarital intercourse.</i>
blanket	Form a blanket like cover over. <i>A blanket ban on tobacco advertising.</i>
buddhism	A religion represented by the many groups (especially in Asia) that profess various forms of the Buddhist doctrine and that venerate Buddha.
calming	The act of appeasing (as by acceding to the demands of.
celibacy	The state of abstaining from marriage and sexual relations. <i>A priest who had taken a vow of celibacy.</i>
contemplation	Religious meditation. <i>Substantial fitting work is in contemplation.</i>
enlightenment	Education that results in understanding and the spread of knowledge. <i>Robbie looked to me for enlightenment.</i>
fasting	Abstaining from food.
flex	The act of flexing. <i>Flex a muscle.</i>
hunch	An impression that something might be the case. <i>He hunched over his glass.</i>
hush	Make (someone) be quiet or stop talking. <i>Management took steps to hush up the dangers.</i>
instructor	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>A driving instructor.</i>
introspection	The contemplation of your own thoughts and desires and conduct. <i>Quiet introspection can be extremely valuable.</i>
introspective	Characterized by or given to introspection. <i>He grew withdrawn and introspective.</i>

<u>karma</u>	The effects of a person's actions that determine his destiny in his next incarnation.
mat	A piece of coarse material for lying on. <i>The fur on its flank was matted with blood.</i>
mattress	A large thick pad filled with resilient material and often incorporating coiled springs, used as a bed or part of a bed.
meditation	(religion) contemplation of spiritual matters (usually on religious or philosophical subjects). <i>A life of meditation.</i>
meditative	Relating to or absorbed in meditation or considered thought. <i>Meditative techniques.</i>
mesmerism	(in general use) hypnotism.
peaceful	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>They settle their disputes by peaceful means.</i>
pillow	Rest one's head as if on a pillow. <i>His head was pillowed on his arm.</i>
<u>posture</u>	Assume a posture as for artistic purposes. <i>Politicians have neglected our military posture.</i>
premeditation	(law) thought and intention to commit a crime well in advance of the crime; goes to show criminal intent. <i>The defendant said there was no planning or premeditation.</i>
reentrant	Pointing inward.
sleeper	A sleeping pill. <i>He gave me tranquilizers in addition to the sleepers I was already on.</i>
<u>soothing</u>	Having a gently calming effect. <i>A soothing ointment for her sunburn.</i>
<u>stillness</u>	Calmness without winds. <i>Absolute stillness greeted our gaze.</i>
<u>trainee</u>	Someone who is being trained. <i>Trainee solicitors.</i>
transcendental	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature. <i>The transcendental importance of each person's soul.</i>
