## Associations of "Yoga" (30 Words)

<b>abstinence</b>	The trait of abstaining (especially from alcohol). <i><b>Abstinence</b> from premarital intercourse.</i>
<b><u>blanket</u></b>	Form a blanket like cover over. <i>A <b>blanket</b> ban on tobacco advertising.</i>
<b>buddhism</b>	A religion represented by the many groups (especially in Asia) that profess various forms of the Buddhist doctrine and that venerate Buddha.
<b>calming</b>	The act of appeasing (as by acceding to the demands of.
<b>celibacy</b>	The state of abstaining from marriage and sexual relations. <i>A priest who had taken a vow of <b>celibacy</b>.</i>
<b>contemplation</b>	Religious meditation. <i>Substantial fitting work is in <b>contemplation</b>.</i>
<b>enlightenment</b>	Education that results in understanding and the spread of knowledge. <i>Robbie looked to me for <b>enlightenment</b>.</i>
<b>fasting</b>	Abstaining from food.
<b>flex</b>	The act of flexing. <i><b>Flex</b> a muscle.</i>
<b>hunch</b>	An impression that something might be the case. <i>He <b>hunched</b> over his glass.</i>
<b><u>hush</u></b>	Make (someone) be quiet or stop talking. <i>Management took steps to <b>hush</b> up the dangers.</i>
<b>instructor</b>	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>A driving <b>instructor</b>.</i>
<b><u>introspection</u></b>	The contemplation of your own thoughts and desires and conduct. <i>Quiet <b>introspection</b> can be extremely valuable.</i>
<b><u>introspective</u></b>	Characterized by or given to introspection. <i>He grew withdrawn and <b>introspective</b>.</i>

<b><u>karma</u></b>	The effects of a person's actions that determine his destiny in his next incarnation.
<b>mat</b>	A piece of coarse material for lying on. <i>The fur on its flank was <b>matted</b> with blood.</i>
<b>mattress</b>	A large thick pad filled with resilient material and often incorporating coiled springs, used as a bed or part of a bed.
<b>meditation</b>	(religion) contemplation of spiritual matters (usually on religious or philosophical subjects). <i>A life of <b>meditation</b>.</i>
<b>meditative</b>	Relating to or absorbed in meditation or considered thought. <i><b>Meditative</b> techniques.</i>
<b>mesmerism</b>	(in general use) hypnotism.
<b>peaceful</b>	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>They settle their disputes by <b>peaceful</b> means.</i>
<b>pillow</b>	Rest one's head as if on a pillow. <i>His head was <b>pillowed</b> on his arm.</i>
<b><u>posture</u></b>	Assume a posture as for artistic purposes. <i>Politicians have neglected our military <b>posture</b>.</i>
<b>premeditation</b>	(law) thought and intention to commit a crime well in advance of the crime; goes to show criminal intent. <i>The defendant said there was no planning or <b>premeditation</b>.</i>
<b>reentrant</b>	Pointing inward.
<b>sleeper</b>	A sleeping pill. <i>He gave me tranquilizers in addition to the <b>sleepers</b> I was already on.</i>
<b><u>soothing</u></b>	Having a gently calming effect. <i>A <b>soothing</b> ointment for her sunburn.</i>
<b><u>stillness</u></b>	Calmness without winds. <i>Absolute <b>stillness</b> greeted our gaze.</i>
<b><u>trainee</u></b>	Someone who is being trained. <i><b>Trainee</b> solicitors.</i>
<b>transcendental</b>	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature. <i>The <b>transcendental</b> importance of each person's soul.</i>
