Synonyms of "Yummy" as an adjective (8 Words)

appetizing	Appealing to or stimulating the appetite especially in appearance or aroma. <i>The appetizing aroma of sizzling bacon.</i>
<u>delectable</u>	Capable of arousing sexual desire. <i>Delectable handmade chocolates.</i>
delicious	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste. <i>A delicious irony.</i>
<u>luscious</u>	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste. <i>A luscious and fragrant dessert wine.</i>
pleasant-tasting	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste.
<u>scrumptious</u>	(of a person) very attractive. <i>He is simply the most scrumptious thing on two legs.</i>
<u>tasty</u>	Involving or good at fighting. <i>Some tasty piano licks.</i>

toothsome

Acceptable to the taste or mind.
A *toothsome* bimbo.
