## Synonyms of "Yummy" as an adjective (8 Words)

appetizing	Appealing to or stimulating the appetite especially in appearance or aroma. The <b>appetizing</b> aroma of sizzling bacon.
<u>delectable</u>	Capable of arousing sexual desire. <b>Delectable</b> handmade chocolates.
delicious	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste. A <b>delicious</b> irony.
<u>luscious</u>	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste. A <b>luscious</b> and fragrant dessert wine.
pleasant-tasting	Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste.
<u>scrumptious</u>	(of a person) very attractive. <i>He is simply the most <b>scrumptious</b> thing on two legs.</i>
<u>tasty</u>	Involving or good at fighting. Some <b>tasty</b> piano licks.



toothsome Acceptable to the taste or mind. *A toothsome* bimbo.
