appetizing aroma.

The **appetizing** aroma of sizzling bacon.

delectable Capable of arousing sexual desire.

Delectable handmade chocolates.

delicious Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste.

A **delicious** irony.

luscious Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste. *A luscious* and fragrant dessert wine.

pleasant-tasting Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste.

scrumptious (of a person) very attractive.

He is simply the most **scrumptious** thing on two legs.

Involving or good at fighting.

Some **tasty** piano licks.



toothsome

Acceptable to the taste or mind. *A toothsome* bimbo.
