<b>battery-acid</b>	Street name for lysergic acid diethylamide.
<b>dose</b>	A venereal infection. <i>I wanted to give you a <b>dose</b> of the hell you put me through.</i>
<b>dot</b>	The United States federal department that institutes and coordinates national transportation programs; created in 1966. <i>A symbol depicted in coloured <b>dots</b>.</i>
<b>elvis</b>	Street name for lysergic acid diethylamide.
<b>loony toons</b>	Street name for lysergic acid diethylamide.
<b>lucy in the sky with diamonds</b>	A state in midwestern United States.
<b>pane</b>	A panel or section of panels in a wall or door.

- superman** A person with great powers and abilities.

- window pane** An opening in a wall or screen that admits light and air and through which customers can be served.
- zen buddhism** A religion represented by the many groups (especially in Asia) that profess various forms of the Buddhist doctrine and that venerate Buddha.
